## **General requirements in the field of environmental protection at holding events**

**Version: 2023-07-03**

1. When developing proposals for holding events for the AGR, the Bidder / Counterparty is obliged to take into account the environmental legislation of the Russian Federation and the relevant requirements contained in federal laws and other regulatory legal acts of the Russian Federation, laws and other regulatory legal acts of the subjects of the Russian Federation. Proposals of the Bidder must fully comply with the environmental legislation of the Russian Federation, including with regard to the choice of venues for the proposed events, taking into account the current local legislative requirements. All employees of the Counterparty (as well as those of third parties involved in accordance with the GPC) are required to comply with the rules on environmental protection during the preparation and conduct of events, as well as at the stage of final work after the events.
  2. When developing and implementing activities for the AGR, the Bidder /Counterparty is obliged to comply with the AGR Business Partner Code of Conduct, in particular its provisions regarding environmental protection.
  3. In addition, event concepts, production materials, and design solutions should be developed taking into account the minimization of the ecological footprint, as far as possible (for example: it is preferable to choose materials that are recyclable, avoid — if possible — production in favor of rent, produce souvenirs from recycled materials or with the addition of recycled materials).
  4. The removal and disposal of all waste generated after the events is carried out independently and in a timely manner by the Counterparty with involvement of organizations having appropriate permits and licenses. The Counterparty is obliged to provide the AGR representative upon request with a waste disposal contract and certificates confirming the transfer of waste and its appropriate disposal. When developing proposals, it is necessary to plan the transfer of all waste belonging to the Counterparty for recycling.
  5. In case of damage to the environment and/or violation of the environmental legislation of the Russian Federation, which occurred as a result of the Counterparty's activities, the Counterparty is obliged to eliminate and compensate for the damage caused, and also independently bears administrative and criminal liability for it.
